LCEF is off to a great start for 2023! We closed 2022 with a grand total of \$76,709 in contributions for education – raising our total contributions since 2012 to \$962,074!

Our contributions covered 28 classroom grants, \$4000 in classroom supplies, certification testing grants, 1900 children received books in Loudon County through Imagination Library, and \$8,500 was contributed in Scholarships. We graduated 10 from the Leadership Class of 2022 and fourteen will begin Orientation for the Leadership Class of 2023! The first Women on Point was a grand success and plans are already being made for 2024! We couldn't do any of this without your support!

Champions of Education Difference Makers


